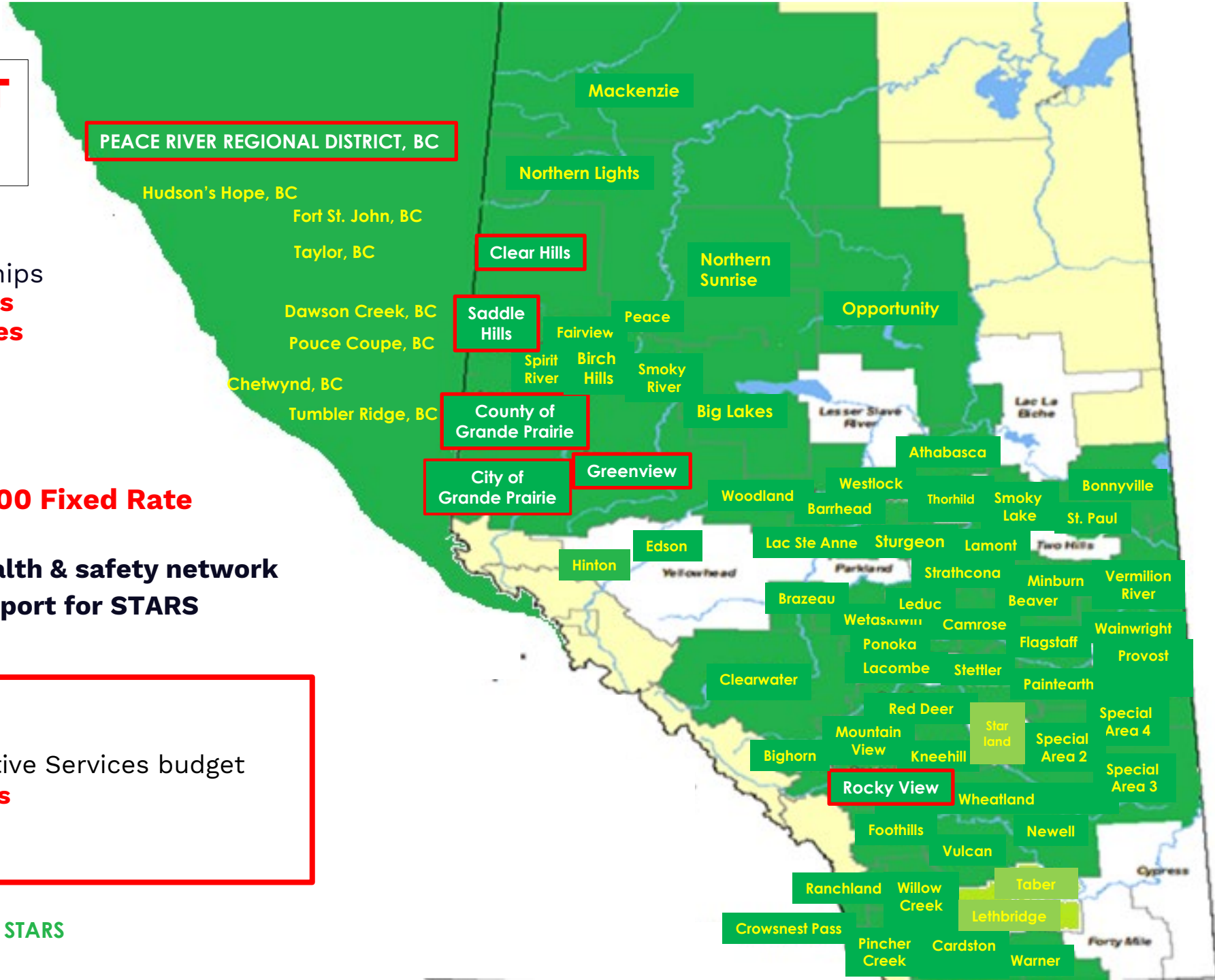

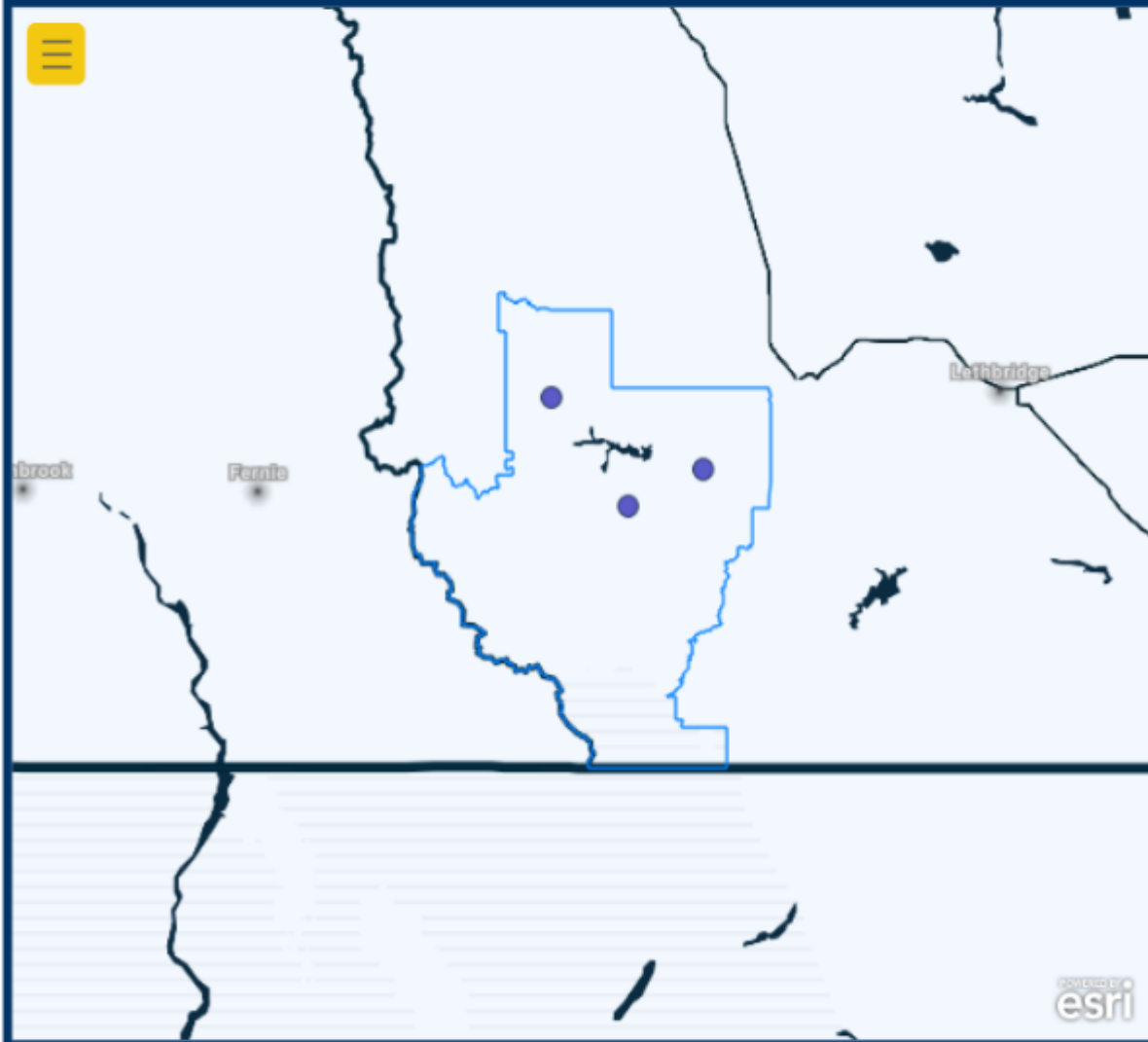

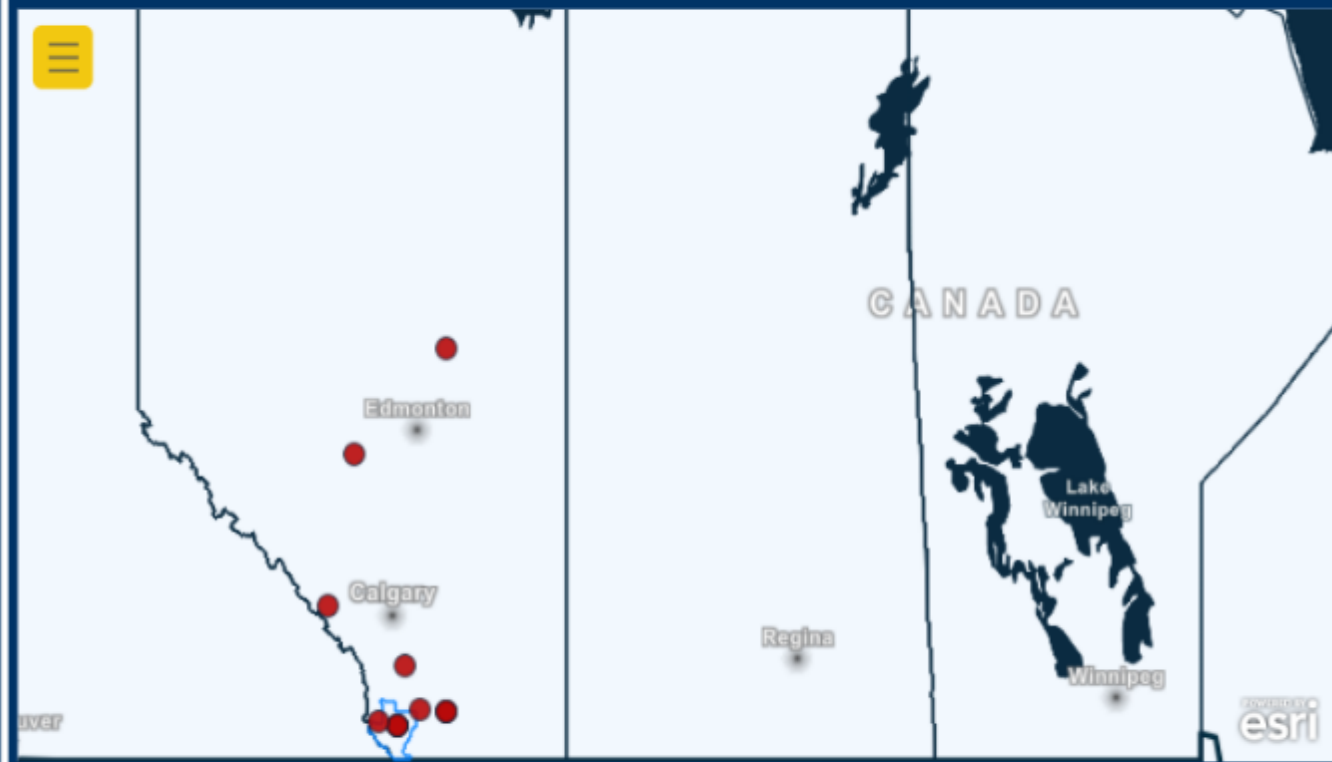


# Within MD of Pincher Creek Boundaries - Patients Flown by STARS (2010-Present)

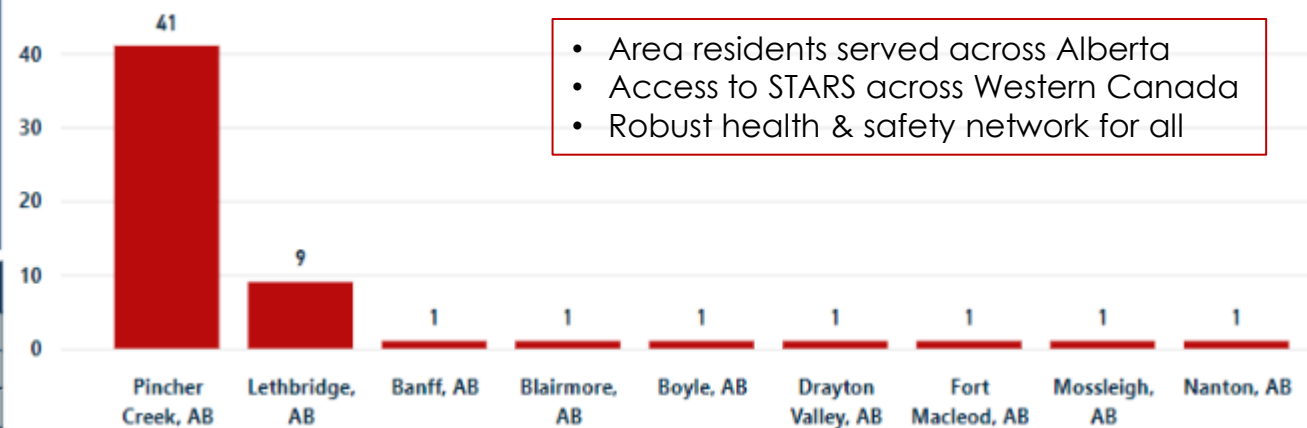
## MD of Pincher Creek Residents Flown by STARS
