



- \* Transport Physician's in the ELC
- \* Coordinate complex logistics with receiving hospitals i.e.; schedule Neurosurgeons, Cardiac Cath Lab, CAT Scanner
- \* Face-to-face decision making / real-time diagnostics
- \* Result: direct delivery of critical patients to operating room
