Dear Council Members,

Pincher Creek Curling Club applied for the provincial 1 million dollar CFEP grant.

In order to receive the grant, we are requesting the MD write a letter of support for the curling rink stating they will donate the remaining \$868,637.00 which can be in the form of a caveat letter and state the funding would be provided if CFEP funding is approved.

Our goal is to have your support to write this letter so we can successfully be awarded the grant. After that happens and as donations come in, amounts actually needed by the Town and MD will be less. At this point we are just asking for the letter of support.

The Town of Pincher Creek has passed motions at meetings to commit \$1.25 to the curling build.

The Town of Pincher Creek is in the process of setting up a trust fund. Once complete, they will be placing the \$1.25 million in the trust fund. This will allow the curling club to accept large donations and be able to offer donation receipts. We have had donors come forward wanting to donate up to \$10,000.00 but of course are requesting donation receipts. This trust fund will also ensure the funds are not used for other projects.

The curling club raised \$200,000.00. We are continuing to raise money and are confident once we can deposit to the trust fund and write receipts the donations will be coming in. We have corporate interest and require anywhere from 50-80% of funding in place before they donate.

Due to the net zero grant not coming to fruition, we removed the cost of the solar panels and the cost of the renovations to the existing building. All costs attached to this letter are for the new curling rink build only.

This will allow the curling rink club to start the much needed curling rink build this year and have it completed by September of next year our 100th anniversary of curling in Pincher Creek. Our insurance has gone from \$1000 a couple years ago to over \$7000 now due to the state of the building. This is an urgent matter to keep curling in our community.

I am more than happy to attend a council meeting and answer any questions or concerns.

PINCHER CREEK CURLING CENTER - 2023

The proposed location is adjacent to the Pincher Creek Recreation Center and is a standalone building attached to the existing building with a 9'x 10' walkway that has 2 - 1 hour fire rated doors separating the buildings. The building itself is only 11' to the top of eve and has a 1.5/12 low slope to peak. Low profile is to match the bowling alley structure and the outside dimensions are to be 70' wide and 220' long.
