Subject: Formal Objection to the Proposed Water Utility Rate Increase

To the Members of the City Council and the Utility Board,

I am writing as a resident of **Lundbreck** to formally express my opposition to the proposed amendment, 1359-25 regarding the increase in water utility rates.

While I understand the necessity of maintaining our city's infrastructure, I strongly object to the current proposal for the following reasons:

- **Financial Burden:** The proposed increase is significant and places an undue financial strain on households, particularly those on fixed incomes or middle-class families already facing rising inflation.
- **Lack of Transparency:** There has not been sufficient public disclosure regarding how these additional funds will be allocated or why alternative cost-saving measures were not prioritized.
- **Proportionality:** I believe the rate hike is disproportionate to the actual improvements planned for our local water system.

I kindly request that the Council reconsider this amendment and explore alternative funding solutions or a more gradual implementation of any necessary rate adjustments. I also request that my objection be formally recorded in the minutes of the upcoming public hearing on this matter.
